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Sonifex showing new comms units

Sonifex, a manufacturer of audio products for broadcasters, is showcasing two new products at BroadcastAsia2013.

The CM-TB8 Channel Talkback Control Unit is a self-contained communications unit providing eight channels of four-wire communication.

Housed in a 1RU mount enclosure, the unit is equipped with individual connections for both a headset on five-pin XLR and microphone/headphones on XLR/stereo TRS jack, with the current selection indicated on the front panel.

To cater to a wide range of microphone types, the gain setting for each input can be individually set between +6dB and +68dB. Another addition is the +48V phantom power.

At **booth 5M7-10**, Sonifex is also introducing the new Redbox RB-IPE IP extender for GPIO and Analogue Control Signals.

This is designed to provide remote control of GPIO and analogue control voltages over an Ethernet network.

Configured using a built-in Web server, two units can control each other across an Ethernet network, or a single unit can be controlled via Ethernet commands and the Web server interface.
