SLO, Norway Norsk Rikskringkasting (NRK) in Norway is among

The DHY-03 hybrid has a number of features, which combine to offer probably the best rejection ratio of any hybrid at between 75 dB and 80 dB.

International settings and universal line compatibility allow a good technical impedance match with the line, no matter where it is in the world.

Additionally, the unit has internal memof other mixed signals. This improves the



ability of the hybrid to take calls on mobile phones or where there are other delays, for example on satellite and conference calls.
